Biblical Eldership BIBLICAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR ALL ELDERS

1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9, & 1 Peter 5:1-4.

- The W.H.O. believes that most developed countries characterise old age commencing at 60+ years
- Most 3rd world Countries follow a more traditional definition of old age.
 - \rightarrow between 50 to 65 years old.
- In most western Countries, Elders are people acknowledged for their <u>experience</u>, <u>prominence</u>, <u>dependability</u>, and <u>power</u> within their community.

Three New Testament passages record key qualifications for Eldership

1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9, & 1 Peter 5:1-4. Desire for Eldership activated by the Holy Spirit

- The person <u>recognizes a deep desire birthed within</u> him by the Holy Spirit Acts 20:28
 - → Notice that it is <u>the Holy Spirit who appoints a</u> <u>person as an overseer</u>.
- The person senses the Holy Spirit stirring within him.

1 Timothy 3:1 NLT/NIV

- → Aspiration <u>driven by the Holy Spirit</u>
- The person <u>realizes the awesome responsibility</u> <u>entrusted to him by God</u>. **1 Peter 5:1 & 2 NLT**

The overriding & essential qualification is: The charge and the call from the Holy Spirit.

- 1. The Holy Spirit <u>deposited the pastoral desire</u> in their hearts.
- 2. The Holy Spirit <u>imparted the compulsion</u> from within them.
- 3. The Holy Spirit <u>provided the power</u>, <u>wisdom</u> and <u>appropriate gifts</u> to care for the flock.

Three key reasons why Elders should be Biblically qualified

- 1 To protect the church from an unqualified Eldership.
 - From a <u>quick-tempered</u> man. A <u>quarrelsome</u> man
 - A <u>controlling</u> personality. An <u>undisciplined</u> man
 - A dishonest, unfaithful man. An immature man.
 - A man of <u>inadequate</u> <u>discernment</u>. A <u>greedy</u> man.
 - A man who is a *poor witness* in the community.

2 To maintain The Lord's standard for all Elders

- → For both *moral* and *spiritual* character.
- → Biblical qualifications <u>decides the standard</u> for the rest of the Church.
- 3 To deepen the Elders' shepherding skills.
 - → Remember the attributes for Eldership?
 - "not quick-tempered," "gentle,"
 - "hospitable,"- "not quarrelsome,"
 - "[love] of good," "willing" to shepherd.
 - "able to give instruction in sound doctrine,"
 - → This is a *Biblically unqualified Elder*
 - o A major cause of endless conflict in the Church.
 - o Destroys the joy and enthusiasm in the church.
 - → No one <u>should be allowed to force himself upon the</u> <u>God's people</u> as an Elder/leader.
