Biblical Eldership NEW TESTAMENT CHURCHES UNDERSTOOD THE IMPORTANCE OF ELDERSHIP

Acts 20:17-28; 1 Peter 5:1-4.

- In some Christian circles Elders are people respected for their <u>knowledge</u>, <u>status</u>, <u>reliability</u>, and <u>influence</u> within their denomination.
 - → According to the New Testament: <u>Elders</u> (who are also called pastors, teachers, ministers, overseers, or bishops) and <u>Deacons</u>"
 - → Greek word for 'minister' is diakonos = 'a servant,' or
 - → One who implements the command of another.
 - ightarrow It is <u>not about the individual but the office</u> that matters.
- **Eldership** finds its roots in Old Testament Israel.

Did Moses choose 70 Elders for Israel?

- Numbers 11:16-17.

- No, **God commanded Moses** to select <u>70 Elders</u>.
- God took the Spirit that was upon Moses and <u>put the</u>
 <u>Spirit upon the 70 Elders chosen by Moses</u>.
 - → Israel adopted the symbol of "<u>Shepherding</u>" for their Elders.
 - → New Testament Churches identified their Elders as shepherds as well.
 - → Shepherding God's people is the chief role of <u>Biblical</u> Eldership.

for Elder.

πρεσβύτερος (presbuteros) = Elder/Presbyter; ἐπίσκοπος (episkopos) = Guardian/Overseer & **ποιμὴν** (poimēn) = Shepherd.

Eldership in **Pauline** Churches – Acts 20:17–28.

- Paul stops at Miletus, just south of Ephesus,
- He "calls for the *Elders* of the church" at Ephesus.
- The Greek word is <u>επισκοπους</u> which literally means <u>overseer</u> and sometimes translated "<u>bishop</u>."

Eldership in Non-Pauline Churches.

- "<u>Elder</u>" occurs <u>12 times</u> in the Book of Revelation. with reference to the <u>24 Elders</u> in heaven.
- In 2 & 3 John, John introduces himself as "The Elder"

1 Peter 5:1-4.

- The first thing to note is that Peter calls himself **<u>Elder</u>**.
- The Apostolic office overlapped with that of elder.
- Peter does not want them to "lord it over the flock"
- Peter, by his own example, encourages <u>the Elders</u> to fulfill their calling.
- Peter says <u>all Elders are called to take the humble role</u> as examples & Guardians of the flock of Christ.
